Columbia Community Cares operates at the following sites on Wednesdays from 5 to 8 pm and Saturdays from 10:30 am to 1:30 pm:

- Swansfield Elementary School
- Oakland Mills Middle School
- Howard High School

Volunteer shifts begin at 4 pm for set up; 2-hour shifts are coordinated to accommodate work schedules and flexibility; however, volunteers may sign up to cover the full shift, if available. Product donations are also needed – items noted below:

Non-Perishable: Pasta, pasta sauce, canned tomatoes, tomato sauce, tomato paste, soup, bread, peanut butter, jelly, canned meat (tuna, Spam, Vienna Sausages, salmon), granola bars, cereal, oatmeal, pancake mix, syrup, grits, rice, potatoes, box milk, powdered milk, non-dairy milk, rice, beans, quinoa, macaroni and cheese, ramen noodles, water, coffee, sugar, tea, flour, masa, cooking oil, GOYA Adobo, Sazon, olives, ketchup, mustard, mayonnaise.

Perishable: Cheese, queso fresco, eggs, veggies, meats, milk, butter, Chorizo, bacon, tortillas, GOYA Discos (frozen) juices, Produce – plantains, yuca, garlic, cilantro, peppers, Fruits - oranges, bananas, lemons, limes, mango, apples.

Household Items: Paper towels, toilet paper, household cleaners, soap, laundry detergent, bleach, plastic ware, Lysol spray, Lysol wipes, disinfectants, dish soap, dishwasher detergent.

Personal Care Items: Tampons, sanitary napkins, toiletries, toothpaste, shampoo, adult diapers

Baby Items: Baby diapers (all sizes), baby wipes, baby formula, baby food, soothers, baby bottles.
